ATTENDANCE POLICY

The college follows the standards prescribed by the Pakistan Nursing and midwifery Council (PNMC) and its affiliating university, Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Medical University (SZABMU), Islamabad. Minimum Attendance Requirements

Exception: For Generic BSN and Post-RN BScN students, 85% theory attendance will be accepted under specific certified circumstances listed below.

Permissible Exceptions for 85% Theory Attendance

A student may be granted a reduction to 85% attendance in theory classes only under the following exceptional and verifiable conditions:

1.Death of an Immediate Family Member

(Parents, siblings, spouse, or children)

2.Serious Medical Condition

Certified by a physician from Rawal General & Dental Hospital

3.Childbirth (Delivery)

Also certified by Rawal General & Dental Hospital

Documentation Required:

•Valid supporting medical or legal documents must be submitted within 7 working days of absence.

•Students are required to submit a 25% Make-up Assignment/Report after above mentioned permissible events.

Unexcused Absentees.

Any absence outside the approved exceptions listed above will be treated as a disciplinary matter. Such cases will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee, which may recommend penalties including warning, probation, or suspension from examinations.

Eligibility for Final Examinations

•After considering the allowed exceptions, a minimum of 85% attendance in theory + 100% Clinicals are mandatory.

•Students failing to meet this minimum requirement will not be permitted to appear in the university final examinations, regardless of reason.

1. Scholarship Policy for 04-Year Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)

Programme Terms of Reference

•The Institutional Scholarship Award Committee (ISAC) ensures the transparent selection and disbursement of scholarships. •Annual scholarship slots are allocated for each batch of the BSN Programme based on availability, especially through the PEEF Scholarship for Talent.

2. RIHS Sponsorship / Assistantship Policy

Nursing personnel (CNA, NA, RN) of Rawal Institute of Health Sciences (RIHS) with a minimum of three (03) years of continuous service are eligible to apply for sponsorship for the following

programs: • Post-RN BScN Degree • BSN (Generic) Degree

Key Conditions:

•Sponsored personnel will be exempted from tuition fees.

•In return Post-RN students must sign a 01-year service bond with RIHS Hospital oBSN students must sign a 02-year service bond (excluding internship).

•If a student withdraws from the program before completion, they must reimburse the full tuition fee, as per the signed affidavit.

3. Merit-Based Academic Achievement Scholarships

•Students securing 90% marks or above in their academic performance will be eligible for a Tuition fee waiver as per policy.

4. Scholarship Cancellation Criteria

Scholarships (of all types) will be automatically cancelled under the following circumstances:

Condition	Description
Disciplinary Misconduct	If the student is found guilty of a major disciplinary offense.
Multiple Scholarships	If the student is receiving any other scholarship concurrently.
Attendance Shortfall	If the student fails to meet mandatory attendance requirements.
Political Involvement	If the student is involved in any political activity during their tenure at the institute.

Important Note: All applicants and recipients must comply fully with the scholarship regulations and the student code of conduct.
