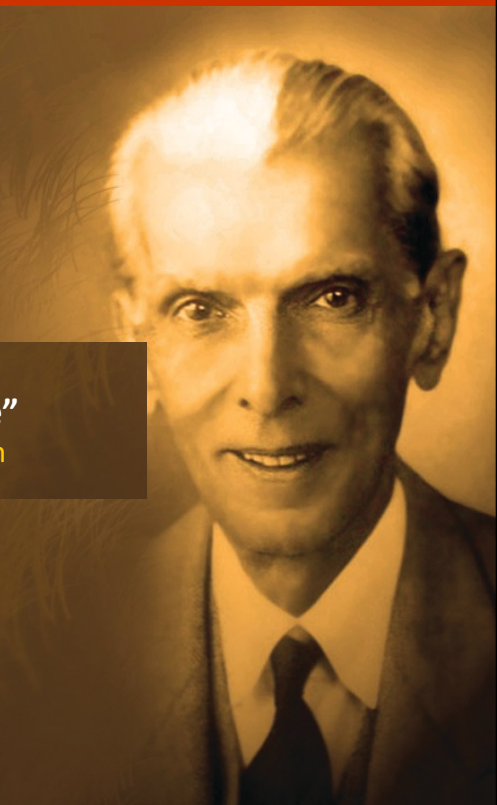


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MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN



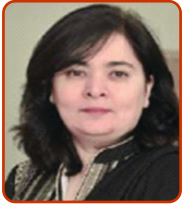

3. Giving Birth/Delivery of a baby certified by above mentioned institute.

A student suffering from any-one of the above conditions has to submit fifteen percent Make-up report to appear in the final examinations. Make-up will be made during the students' vacation period. Any absence other than the above mentioned three reasons will be considered serious disciplinary act and further actions against the student will be taken by the disciplinary committee. After considering the above mentioned reasons, 85% attendance is mandatory anyone having a less than 85 % attendance will not be allowed to appear in university final exam.

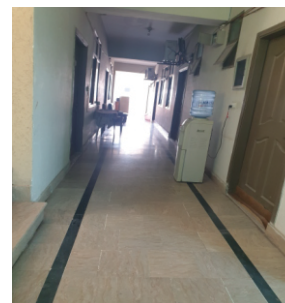
